

Amazon Anti-Aging Store Install & Setup Guide

Adding Your Amazon Affiliate ID

This part is really easy and only takes a few minutes. Login into your site and go to:

Dashboard -> Tools -> Search and Replace

If you don't have that check the plugins page, the search and replace plugin might not be activated. If not, of course activate it and go to the above location.

Next, click on the "Search and Replace" tab.

In the Search For Box add: 123456

In the Replace With: Put in your Amazon Affiliate ID. Check the "Select All Tables" box.

Uncheck the "Dry Run" box.

Check the "Save Changes To Database Box.

Click the "Do Search And Replace" button.

After clicking the Do search & replace button, it will add your affiliate id to all the links. Easy huh? And quick huh?

It would be a good idea to check a couple links. In your Amazon affiliate account they have a link checker. Just go your new site, copy one of the affiliate links and drop it in the amazon link checker.

If a couple of them are good, they should all be good.

Hurray!! You are done.

Only other thing to do is, to go to Dashboard -> Plugins

And activate any plugins that are not activated. Some plugins need the domain to set up, reason why some are not active.

That's all there is to do because it's a turnkey site.
